

1. Petitions, complaints & suo-moto notices on human rights violations:

As per the mandate bestowed by the Act, the Commission started probing in petitions/complaints received on human right violations from **mid of Dec 2015**. During two and a half months, we have received 87 petitions and taken 02 *suo-moto* notices on Kasur Child Abuse and Tharparker incidents. Among 87 petitions, 10 petitions have been disposed of while other are being investigated at different levels. For more details, please refer to the below tables.
